# 2017 giving results

The following figures summarize giving to the University of Minnesota in fiscal year 2017, which ran from July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017. The \$337 million raised in gifts and commitments was the second-highest total in University history, and the \$237 million distributed to the U was the highest ever. These figures are reported by the University of Minnesota Foundation, which raises and manages gifts to the U of M.

- Organizations 3,833 **5%**






### Purpose of 2017 gifts

Total: \$337 million

The \$337 million in gifts raised includes outright gifts, pledges, and future commitments.

- Student support \$98 million 29%
- Academic program support\* \$78 million 23%
- Capital improvements \$54 million **16%**
- Research \$48 million 14%
- Outreach and community engagement \$32 million 10%
- Faculty support \$27 million 8%



#### Types of 2017 gifts

Total: \$337 million

- Cash and pledges \$222 million 66%
- Future (estate and deferred gifts) \$112 million 33%
- Property and in-kind gifts \$3 million 1%
